LEVEL REQUIREMENTS

We recommend taking more classes than indicated below to achieve your highest level of training. Below is the bare minimum requirement for each age group.

Age 3-5	Two 1-hour group class per week	
Age 6-8	Two 1.5-hours group classes per week	
Age 9-11	Three 1.5-hours group classes per week	
Age 12+	Four 1.5-hours group classes per week	



Tuition Policies

- 1. Tuition is collected at the beginning of every season, for the entire year or season. The dance season will include two regular seasons Fall (17 weeks) & Spring (21 weeks), and one Summer Session (8 weeks).
- 2. Annual tuition will be 38 weeks total for Fall & Spring. Summer classes are billed separately and will be announced in Spring.
- 3. Tuition can be paid by single class (walk-in) rate, seasonal rate or annual rate.
- 4. Tuition can be paid via cash, check, Zelle, Venmo, or by card through the parent portal. Please note that any payments made through the portal will be charged with a 3% convenience fee.
- 5. Tuition is charged per student, with a multi-class discount available.
- 6. There will be no discount given for multiple students from the same family. Credits cannot be transferred in between friends & family members.
- 7. A walk-in class rate will be charged to anyone that will not be paying for semester/annual tuition.
- 8. A late fee of \$35 will be added for any tuition received 2 weeks after each semester begins.
- 9. Bounced checks will be charged a \$40 bank fee per check.
- 10. A student may not attend class if tuition is not paid.
- 11. Please be aware that if you decide not to continue participating in the dancing class, there are no refunds, no credits of tuition.
- 12. Under special circumstances (injury/moving/etc), please provide us with an official letter. A refund processing fee of \$50 will be charged as well along with the refund.
- 13. Financial plans may be granted upon request, please contact admin to discuss your financing options.
- 14. Showcase and our Annual Recital are mandatory to attend (Additional fees may apply).
- 15. You must inform your instructor or the studio 24 hours prior, if you're not able to attend classes. If you fail to do so, you are not eligible in a makeup class.



- 16. Missed classes can be made up by taking other classes (approved by the instructor or director), or we will provide you with a Zoom Recording of the class you missed for self make-up at home.
- 17. All Zoom links will expire within 48 hours, it is your responsibility to view before the expiration.
- 18. Makeup Classes must be made up within one month of the class that was missed.
- 19. Private or small group (4 or less) instruction is subject to additional charges of classroom and tuition fees. This policy also applies when a regular class has only 4 or less students present.





Frequently Asked Questions

1. When do I pay for tuition?

Tuition is collected at the beginning of every semester, for the entire semester. The dance year will include 2 regular class sessions and two intensives. Tuition can be paid, per semester, or annually (10% discount). Please be aware that if you decide not to continue participating in the dance class, there are no refunds, no credits of tuition.

2. What discounts do you offer?

Students who pay annual tuition will get a 10% discount. The more regular classes you attend, the more discounts you will receive. There will be no discount given for multiple students from the same family. Credits cannot be transferred in between family members.

3. What if I missed the class?

Missed class can be made up by taking another class only if a notification is given at least 24 hours prior to the beginning of the class. Classes must be made up within one month of the class that was missed.

4. How many class hours do you recommend each week?

- Ages 3-5: 2 hours
- Ages 6-8: 3 hours
- Ages 9-11: 4.5 hours
- Ages 12+: 6 hours

5. How do I participate in the competition teams/compete in a solo?

You must meet the class requirements for competition teams. We may talk to you in private if your child has potential. If you are interested, please ask us as well and we will guide you through the process.



6. Why should you participate in competitions?

It will help the child to gain confidence, discipline, exposure, and improve in time management skills. We do want our students to succeed both academically and artistically hence they will have to learn to manage their time to succeed in both. Furthermore, these competitions will look good for their college application in the future. The students will also have many opportunities to be exposed to the art world and understand the importance of art for their future growth and development.

7. What benefit students can get from us.

- We help students who dance in our studio to request P.E. Waivers.
- We have many connections with universities, art schools, and big arts organizations internationally such as UC, Irvine, OCSA, Pacific Symphony, Beijing Dance Academy, Bowers Museum just to name a few.
- We help students who dance in our studio to complete their community service hours.
- We provide scholarships for outstanding students every year.
- We host multiple masterclasses throughout the year.
